By-Law Number 02-18

**A BY-LAW TO PROHIBIT THE THROWING, PLACING, OR DEPOSITING OF
REFUSE OR DEBRIS ON WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY**

Whereas Section 210(82) of the Municipal Act, R.S.O., 1990, Chapter M.45 provides that the Council of a Municipality may pass by-laws for prohibiting the throwing, placing or depositing of refuse or debris on property of the Municipality;

And Whereas it is deemed desirable and expedient to prohibit the throwing, placing, or depositing of refuse or debris on property of the Municipality;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Elizabethtown-Kitley hereby enacts as follows:

1. No person shall throw, place or deposit refuse or debris on any property of the Municipality, other than those areas designated by the Municipality.
2. Every person who contravenes any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offence and on conviction of his or her first offence is liable under this by-law to pay the set fine as provided for in the Provincial Offences Act.
3. Every person who contravenes any provision of this by-law a second and subsequent time is guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a fine not more than \$5000 as provided for in the Provincial Offences Act.
4. By-law number 01-62 of the Township of Elizabethtown-Kitley is repealed in its entirety on the day the approval of the set is received by the Township.
5. This by-law will come into effect upon receipt of the approved set fines by the Chief Judge of Ontario and may be referred to as the Prohibition of Refuse or Debris on Municipal Property by-law.


