


The United Counties of Leeds and Grenville are undertaking a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (MCEA) for the replacement of the Lyn Creek Bridge. Lyn Creek Bridge is located on Main Street within the Village of Lyn, approximately 110 m south of the intersection of Main Street and Perth Street. The structure location is shown on the key map below.

The project is being completed as a Schedule 'B' undertaking in accordance with the MCEA, which applies to municipal infrastructure projects including roads, bridges, water, and wastewater projects. The study includes a review of structure replacement alternatives, and associated potential impacts on the study area environment.



Public, agency, and stakeholder consultation is an important component of the Environmental Assessment process. A Public Information Centre (PIC) will be held on **Thursday, March 26, 2026, from 4:30 PM to 8:30 PM at Christ United Church, located at 12 Perth St, Lyn, Ontario**, to provide additional information, answer questions regarding the project, identify the nature of the work, and solicit feedback and comments.

The PIC will consist of a drop-in type format with displays showing the preliminary recommended plan for the bridge replacement. Staff from the United Counties and Project Lead Consultant will be on hand to answer any questions. Subject to comments received and the receipt of necessary approvals, the United Counties of Leeds and Grenville intend to proceed with the planning, design, and construction of this project.
